SUBJECT: Syringe Prices for the Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI)

New prices for syringes for the Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI), for the period 01 January through 31 December 2006, have been posted in 'PROBUY' on the Procurement Section's intranet site: <https://intranet.paho.org/AM/PRO/PRO.asp>. With this information, PWRs and Centers can submit to PRO a PA (Purchase Authorization) without having to submit a request for PE (Price Estimate).

Care should be taken to ensure that the quantities ordered are a multiple of the packaging units indicated in the price list. In addition to the cost of the syringes, and actual cost for freight and insurance, Member States will be billed a 3% service charge, based on the total cost of the syringes. PAs also have to include estimated freight charges, the cost of which is expressed as a percentage of the cost of the syringes. Air freight charges represent 120% of the total cost of the syringes, and ocean freight charges 30%. It is understood that these averages are for PA purposes only, and that Member States will be invoiced based on actual cost.

Lead time for delivery is approximately 6 weeks for air freight and 3 months for ocean freight, from the date the PA is received by PRO.

It is important that Country Offices and Centers provide FCH/IM with quarterly updates of the Member States' requirements. This will enable PRO to take the necessary steps to ensure timely availability of the syringes throughout the year.
