To Participate

Who can be members of the Forum?

Any national pharmaceutical association in the Region of the Americas can apply for membership in the Forum and participate in its programs and activities.

A national pharmaceutical association eligible to apply for membership in the Forum shall be defined as an independent, nongovernmental association that represents pharmacists in that country, and whose activities include all aspects of educational, professional, and scientific interests of the pharmaceutical profession. A “nongovernmental association” is defined as an organization that elects its own officers, hires its own staff, and determines its own statutes except for such legal requirements as may required by the laws of the country where it exists.

The membership apply should be approved by Executive Committee of the Forum.

How can pharmacists to get involve in Forum’s projects and activities?

Pharmacists who want to get involved in Forum’s projects and activities, should communicate their interest to their national pharmaceutical association,

Also can send an application letter direct to the Secretariat of the Pharmaceutical Forum of the Americas, at the Pan American Health Organization, Washington DC, in the address further on indicate.

What is the procedure to apply for membership?

National and regional pharmaceutical associations should send an application letter to the Executive Committee of the Forum, through the Secretariat of the Pharmaceutical Forum of the Americas, at the Pan American Health Organization in Washington DC.

The application should include, the following information:

- Association's name
- Association's profile (a brief information of not more than one page)
- Association's main goals
- Number of members
- Founding date
- Requirements for membership
- Intention and resources for financial support
