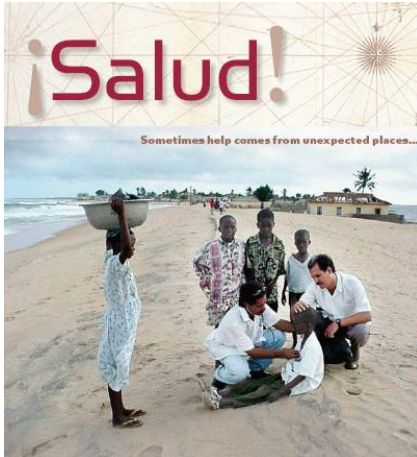


## TPIH RESIDENTS ORGANIZED SCREENING OF THE DOCUMENTARY ¡Salud! FOR STAFF AT PAHO HEADQUARTERS

The participants in the PAHO Training Program in International Health (TPIH) 2006 organized a screening of the acclaimed documentary, *¡Salud!*, for PAHO staff on 6 December 2006. *¡Salud!* explores the case of Cuba, a country that for 40 years has taken health professionals to other nations. Traveling from Africa to the Americas, *¡Salud!* explores the hearts and minds of Cuban health professionals serving overseas as well as that of international medical students in Cuba. Through these stories and expert testimony from around the world, *¡Salud!* documents some of the competing agendas that mark the battle for global health and the complexities in making health care a universal human right. The film, introduced by Dr. Fitzhugh Mullan, Murdock Head Professor of Medicine and Health Policy at George Washington University, was followed by an expert panel consisting of Dr. Peter G. Bourne, Executive Producer, Mr. Dagoberto Rodríguez, Chief of the Interests Section of Cuba in Washington and Dr. Charles Godue, Chief of the Human Resources for Health Unit for PAHO.
