Working Group 2:

Some key issues to be considered in the discussion include country priorities, status of policies and programs, opportunities for coordination or integration with relevant ongoing initiatives, resource mobilization and allocation and strengthening of community-based and other support networks.
4. For each objective identified, describe the key activity or activities to be implemented and the indicator(s) to be used for monitoring and evaluating progress in implementation. The indicators should be relevant, objective, measurable and verifiable. Both process and impact indicators should be included and the source of information for each indicator should be identified.
5. Save some time to prepare a presentation using the format outlined below
