

HAITI GRANTS - 2006

Grant 387003: Grant from the Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunizations (GAVI) for the project "Injection Safety: Haiti" to improve the injection safety of the national immunization program and waste management in order to reduce the risk of exposure to infections to health workers and minimize the risk of contamination to the population at large and the environment (HM-VD-101/ Grt. 387003).

Period: 1 May 2004 – 31 Dec 2006

Donor: Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunizations (GAVI)

Total Grant: \$494,000

Basic project description

To promote systematic and uniform application of injection safety practices among health workers and the general population for the safest delivery of vaccines and disposal of syringes and other materials used in vaccination activities and adequate waste management.

Expected results (deliverables/outputs)

1. Injection Safety Assessment to ensure systematic implementation of the national plan for injection safety and waste management at the national, departmental and institutional levels.
2. Adequate annual supply of AD syringes and safety boxes at the central, departmental and district levels
3. Training and supervision of health workers in injection safety practices
4. Strengthened monitoring and evaluation of injection safety as well as surveillance for needle-stick injuries
