Title: Strengthening Emergency Disaster Response Capacity in Haiti

Period: 1 April 2005 – 31 July 2006

Total Grant: \$413,223.00

Donor: Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA)

Purpose

To reduce the vulnerability of the population of Haiti to natural disasters such as floods, landslides and cyclones.

Expected Results

1. Strengthen health disaster management component at departmental level in three provinces.
2. Strengthen disaster preparedness capacity in one particularly vulnerable community of each province.
3. Improve national response mechanism in supporting two departments and disaster response authorities at central level, and national DCP's (Haiti and Dominican Republic). The beneficiaries will be the local population of the three targeted departments: Grande Anse: 440,000; Sud: 778,000 and Sud-Est: 500,000. Total: 1,718,000 persons).
