In accordance with Resolution CD44.R14 of the 44th Directing Council of the Pan American Health Organization (PAHO), held in September 2003, the Executive Committee established an open-ended Working Group to review the future of PAHO in the 21st Century.

The President of the Executive Committee convened the first meeting of this open-ended Working Group in Roseau, Dominica, on February 26 and 27, 2004, to discuss the “Terms of Reference” on the future of PAHO in the 21st Century and prepared a Work Plan on the action required before the 134th Session of the Executive Committee scheduled for June 2004. The Group comprised selected members of the Executive Committee, namely Argentina, Barbados, Costa Rica, and Peru, representatives of international organizations, and other Member States of PAHO.
