

## Section 2: Employment Situation

### Note:

The idea in this regard was to construct an indicator that would define the different groups or social strata. The purpose of this module is to help facilitate this definition by focusing on occupation, housing, and education. And while these three indicators alone are insufficient, they nevertheless perform a desired group of characteristics. In view of the wide variation between the countries, it is recommended that each define its "socioeconomic" levels, based on specific characteristics, and continue in this manner to their analysis. However, in order to make comparisons between countries, it would be useful to define which groups of categories are to be used, i.e. high, middle-high, middle-low, low, very, low, etc. The questions are self-explanatory.
