- To date, 44 countries and territories in LAC, are expected to participate in VWA 2010 between April 24 and May 1. This year, VWA will coordinate its efforts with the 5th annual European Immunization Week (EIW) and the first ever Eastern Mediterranean Vaccination Week (EMVW).

- Proposed launch sites for VWA 2010 include:
 - La Mosquitia Region in Nicaragua—April 24th
 - Las Cruces, New Mexico (Coordinated event with National Infant Immunization Week)—April 26th
 - Border between Suriname/French Guiana (a bi-Regional event, PAHO-EURO)—April 27th
 - Haiti/Dominican Republic Border—May 1st
- VWA 2010 posters and stickers will be sent to country offices beginning on 23 March. Three series of posters were created this year, utilizing the Sesame St. characters, Ronaldinho, and images of individuals from throughout the Region.
