
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


























Sources of Financial Resources by Biennia






PAHO/AMRO Income for Biennial Program Budget Activities 2008-2009 (in US\$ millions)

PAHO Regular Budget

- Payments toward Quota Assessments provided by 38 Member and Associate States
 - Current 2008-2009 quota assessment receipts: \$159 million
 - Prior biennia assessment receipts: \$35 million
- Miscellaneous Income: \$23.5 million (Exceeded budgeted figure of \$17.5 million)
 - Return on investments: \$21.1 million
 - Currency gains/losses: \$541,000
 - Savings on prior-biennia commitments: \$893,200
 - Other Income: \$940,200


- Regular Budget Allocation to the Region of the Americas: \$80.7 million

PAHO Regular Budget Quota Collections




Payment of 2009 Quota Assessments






Quota Contributions Due as of 31 December






Level of Working Capital Fund





2008-2009 Regular Budget Expenditure Categories (US\$ Million)






PAHO/AMRO Expenditures for Program Budget Activities 2008-2009
