### REPORT ON THE COLLECTION OF QUOTA CONTRIBUTIONS

- 1. The Director has the honor to present a report on the status of quota contributions due from Member, Participating and Associate States as of 31 December 2008 and 31 March 2009, respectively. Furthermore, the Director is pleased to provide an update on the status of the trust fund entitled *Voluntary Contributions for the Priority Programs: Surveillance, Prevention and Management of Chronic Diseases; Mental Health and Substance Abuse; Tobacco; Making Pregnancy Safer; HIV/AIDS and Direction, established in response to Directing Council Resolution CD46.R8.*
- 2. Total quota contributions due as of 1 January 2008 were US\$ 131,081,709, of which \$100,066,959 were received during 2008, resulting in a balance of \$31,014,750 on 31 December 2008. These pending contributions are comprised of \$28,876,455 for 2008 assessments and \$2,138,295 for prior years' (2006-2007) assessments. The status of the quota contributions as of 31 December 2008 and detailed information on the quota payments by Member State and by payment date are included in Annex A.
- 3. In order to provide the Executive Committee with more recent information, an updated table on the status of quota contributions as of 31 March 2009 is attached as Annex B. This table indicates that total quota contributions due on 1 January 2009 were \$126,674,250, of which \$16,114,773 were received as of 31 March 2009. The balance of quota contributions is \$110,559,477.
- 4. The Organization continues to encourage the Member States to make prompt payment of their outstanding quota contributions. As of 31 March 2009, one Member State is in arrears such that it is potentially subject to Article 6.B of the PAHO Constitution. The Secretariat encourages this Member State to make payments towards its arrears of contributions such that, at a minimum, balances for 2006 are liquidated, or to submit for the consideration of the Secretariat a proposal for the settlement of arrears.

5. In response to Directing Council Resolution CD46.R8, Proposed Program Budget of the Pan American Health Organization for the Financial Period 2006-2007, five Member States have made voluntary contributions towards the trust fund established to support the priorities identified in the alternate budget scenario contained in Official Document 317 presented at the 46th Session of the Directing Council. As a result, total income received as of 20 March 2009 for the trust fund, Voluntary Contributions for the Priority Programs, is \$236,505. Member States are encouraged to make a contribution in support of these priority programs.

### **Action by the Executive Committee**

6. In consideration of this report, the Executive Committee may wish to consider the proposed draft resolution found in Annex C.

#### PROPOSED RESOLUTION

### COLLECTION OF QUOTA CONTRIBUTIONS

### The 144th SESSION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE,

Having considered the report of the Director on the collection of quota contributions (Document CE144/23 and Add. I), including a report on the status of the trust fund entitled "Voluntary Contributions for the Priority Programs: Surveillance, Prevention, and Management of Chronic Diseases; Mental Health and Substance Abuse; Tobacco; Making Pregnancy Safer; HIV/AIDS; and Direction";

Noting the information provided on Member States in arrears in the payment of their quota contributions to the extent that they can be subject to the application of Article 6.B of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization;

Noting the provisions of Article 6.B of the PAHO Constitution relating to the suspension of voting privileges of Member States that fail to meet their financial obligations and the potential application of these provisions to those Member States that are not in compliance with their approved deferred payment plan; and

Noting with concern that there are 32 Member States that have not made any payments towards their 2009 quota assessments and that the amount collected for 2009 assessments represents less than 1 percent of total current year assessments,

#### **RESOLVES:**

- 1. To take note of the report of the Director on the collection of quota contributions, including a report on the status of the trust fund entitled "Voluntary Contributions for the Priority Programs: Surveillance, Prevention, and Management of Chronic Diseases; Mental Health and Substance Abuse; Tobacco; Making Pregnancy Safer; HIV/AIDS; and Direction" (Document CE144/23 and Add. I).
- 2. To encourage Member States to continue to provide financial resources in support of the trust fund entitled "Voluntary Contributions for the Priority Programs: Surveillance, Prevention, and Management of Chronic Diseases; Mental Health and Substance Abuse; Tobacco; Making Pregnancy Safer; HIV/AIDS; and Direction".
- 3. To thank the Member States that have already made payments for 2009 and to urge the other Member States to pay all their outstanding contributions as soon as possible.
- 4. To recommend to the 49th Directing Council that the voting restrictions contained in Article 6.B of the PAHO Constitution be strictly applied to any Member State that by the opening of that session has not made substantial payments toward its quota commitments.
- 5. To request the Director to continue to inform the Member States of any balances due and to report to the 49th Directing Council on the status of the collection of quota contributions.
