preface

Since 1995, by mandate of its Governing Bodies, the Pan American Health Organization (PAHO) has collected health information through the Regional Core Health Data Initiative and Country Profiles to monitor the health situation, and particularly the member Governments' mandates adopted by the Organization. With this purpose, we are pleased to present the eleventh brochure of the series "Health Situation in the Americas: Basic Indicators."

The main objective of this annual publication is to present the latest available information on basic health indicators for each country in the Region of the Americas. The indicators were defined using the principle of comparability between countries. Data for indicators related to infant mortality rates, maternal mortality ratios, as well as prenatal and delivery care, come directly from national health authorities of each country. The information on mortality comes from PAHO's Technical Information System, which is periodically updated with data from national mortality systems. Basic statistics on morbidity, resources, access, and coverage of health services are obtained from countries through PAHO's regional technical units. These indicators use information from the Population Division of the United Nations as a denominator. Demographic and socioeconomic indicator data derive from specialized United Nations agencies – the Population Division, FAO, UNICEF, UNESCO, World Bank - and the Office of the Census of the United States. As a consequence, the data might differ from national statistics.

For the first time in this brochure, the mean number of permanent teeth decayed, missing or filled at age 12, the DMFT Index, is being presented. This index replaces the indicator on registered measles' deaths because there have been no reported deaths from this disease in the Americas since 2001. In addition, the French Territories (French Guiana, Guadeloupe, and Martinique) are included within the Latin Caribbean subregion.

In order to highlight progress made by countries in achieving the Millennium Development Goals, this brochure also includes a graph of the current situation in reducing the infant mortality rate from 1990 until 2004, in relation to the 2015 proposed goal. Furthermore, we include a map of the Americas that shows the incidence rate of tuberculosis at the state, provincial or departmental level.

The material presented in the brochure has been compiled, prepared, and reviewed by PAHO staff at Headquarters in Washington, D.C. and PAHO/WHO Country Offices, under the coordination of the Area of Health Analysis and Information Systems. 



Technical notes:

- Basic indicators 11TMF, 15, 17TUR, 18TUR, 19, 20, 21, 36, 41, 52, 56 and 57 form the basis for monitoring progress toward the Millennium Development Goals.
- BI 1: United Nations (countries with 100,000 population and above); US Census Bureau (countries less than 100,000 population). Both agencies are currently reviewing the population projections taking account the last census.
- BI 2 to 10: linear interpolation of indicators published by United Nations (countries with 100,000 population and above).
- Dependency ratio (BI 9) shows the average number of theoretically dependent persons (children under 15 years and persons older than 64 years) per 100 theoretically productive persons (between 15 and 64 years of age).
- Population with access to improved services of water source (17TUR) and sanitation (18TUR) have a different source than previous editions.
- Infant mortality rate, IMR, and maternal mortality ratio, MMR, (BI 19, 20) are reported or estimated by countries. Rate/ratio is presented when the relative standard error is less than 23%; otherwise the number of deaths is shown. An increase of MMR or IMR may reflect an improvement in data coverage and quality.
- Proportion of under-5 registered deaths due to ADD and to ARI (BI 22 and 23) are based on the total number of registered deaths from defined causes in the under-5 years age group as the denominator.
- Estimated mortality rate from homicide (BI 24) includes deaths by legal intervention and operations of war.
- Land transport accidents (BI 26) refer to ICD-10 codes V01-V89. (ICD-10: International Classification of Diseases, Tenth Revision).
- Estimated mortality rates (BI 24, 25, 26, 29Te, 29Me, 29Fe, 30Te, 30Me, 30Fe, 31Te, 31Me, 31Fe, 32Te, 32Me, 32Fe, 33Te, 33Me and 33Fe) were computed based on registered mortality data, applying a correction algorithm for mortality underregistration and a redistribution algorithm for deaths from ill-defined causes. The methodology used is presented in Health Statistics from the Americas, 2003 edition (www.paho.org/English/AnyPub/Sp_591.htm). These rates represent the average quinquennial value, obtained using mortality data from at least two years within the same quinquennium.
- Age-adjusted mortality rates (BI 29Ta, 29Ma, 29Fa, 30Ta, 30Ma, 30Fa, 31Ta, 31Ma, 31Fa, 32Ta, 32Ma, 32Fa, 33Ta, 33Ma and 33Fa) were computed using estimated age-specific mortality rates to control the effect of age distribution differences and to make them comparable, applying the World Standard Population (2,400 under 1 year; 9,600 from 1 to 4 years; 19,000 from 5 to 14 years; 43,000 from 15 to 44 years; 19,000 from 45 to 64 years; and 7,000 65 years and above) (WHO. World Health Statistics Annual; Geneva, 1998).
- DMFT Index (BI 34) expresses the mean number of permanent teeth decayed, missing and filled at age 12.
- Malaria risk areas population (BI 39) shows the proportion of the total population in a country living in high and moderate malaria transmission risk areas. Moderate risk: API between 1 y 10/1,000 pop (BRA: between 10 to 50/1,000); high risk: API > 10/1,000 pop (BRA: > 50/1,000).
- Annual Parasite Index API (BI 40) expresses the number of confirmed malaria cases per 1,000 people living in high and moderate malaria transmission risk areas.
- AIDS basic indicators (BI 43, 44) values could be incomplete due to delayed notification effect.
- Estimates of public expenditure in health (BI 50A) corresponds to expenditures of the institutions of General Government in the function of Health (Division 07) of the international classification of Government Expenditures by functions or purposes of the Systems of National Accounts of United Nations (SCN 1993); derived from the Government Financial Statistical Yearbook 2002 (GFS 2002) from the International Monetary Fund or country's health account studies. Estimates of private expenditure in health (BI 50B) corresponds to the expenditures by the Households Sector in the function of Health or Health and Personal Care of the international classification of Individual Consumption by Purposes of the SCN 1993; derived from data from the Consumer Price Index, household surveys and/or national studies on health accounts. www.paho.org/Spanish/DPMVSHD/HP/nhexp-metodos.htm.
