





Latin America Sub-regional Meeting on Cervical Cancer Prevention: "New technologies for cervical cancer prevention: from scientific evidence to program planning"

Panama City, Panama 2-3 June 2010

Purpose

To review current scientific evidence and discuss country experiences regarding new approaches and technologies for cervical cancer prevention; and to plan collaborative activities that will strengthen national cervical cancer programs.

Objectives

- 1. To showcase available scientific evidence regarding new technologies for cervical cancer screening (HPV DNA Test, Care HPV Test, VIA test, etc.) and discuss various approaches for screening according to different resource levels.
- 2. To review currently available scientific evidence regarding HPV vaccines in terms of cost-effectiveness and discuss delivery strategies, monitoring and evaluation strategies.
- 3. To share successful experiences carried out in Latin American countries on testing and incorporating new technologies for cervical cancer prevention into public health programs.
- 4. To plan collaborative activities with partner organizations in order to strengthen cervical cancer prevention programs and support introduction of new approaches and technologies.

Expected Results

- 1. Deepened knowledge of the available scientific evidence regarding new technologies for cervical cancer prevention, including new screening tests and HPV vaccines.
- 2. Awareness of available tools and useful resources for program managers to strengthen cervical cancer prevention programs and aid decision making regarding the introduction of new approaches and technologies.
- 3. Plan of activities to support country program managers on how to strengthen cervical cancer programs and incorporate new approaches and/or technologies for cervical prevention.
- 4. Strengthened partnerships and alliances that help promote synergies between public health program managers and partner organizations working in the area of cervical cancer prevention.
