- Developed a platform for clinical trials registers that allows integrating, characterizing, and accounting for research that is taking place. Define standards for trial registration and promote registration compliance
- Promote the systematic use of research results to inform public health policies and that researchers address health policy needs
- Define standardized processes for the development of technical documents (Guidelines) that ensure these are informed by research evidence and that facilitates putting evidence in context

- A consulted regional position statement prepared for the consideration of the 48th Directing Council

- To have appropriate representation of a Regional perspective at the Ministerial Forum.
- To enable the technical dialogue and consultation with representatives from the health sector, and other sectors such as science and technology and education
- To protect the achievements and progress made, and give continuation to the various agreements and consultations in which the Region is already involved.


