



### World Hepatitis Day 2011— Brief notes for collaborators requesting information

#### Background:

In 2010 the 63<sup>rd</sup> World Health Assembly (WHA) of WHO, called for a comprehensive response to viral hepatitis. As mandated by the WHA, from 2011 onwards, World Hepatitis Day is promoted on 28 July in order to provide an opportunity for awareness raising and greater understanding of viral hepatitis as a global public health problem, and to stimulate the strengthening of preventive and control measures of hepatitis-related morbidity and mortality in all Member States.

The World Hepatitis Alliance is a non-governmental organisation working in partnership with the WHO to coordinate World Hepatitis Day.

#### Strategic objective:

The overarching strategic objective of World Hepatitis Day is to convince key stakeholders of the urgency to take action to prevent, identify and treat viral hepatitis.

- Ministries of Health and policy makers
- Medical and health practitioners
- The general public
- Existing advocacy groups and activists
