### REPORT ON THE COLLECTION OF QUOTA CONTRIBUTIONS

- 1. The Director has the honor to present a report on the status of assessed contributions as of 31 July 2012. Collections are shown by Member States, Participating States, and Associate Member, and by date of payment (see Annex A).
- 2. Total contributions received as of 31 July 2012 were US\$ 68,656,034<sup>1</sup> compared to \$78,515,999, and \$79,405,269 received during the same periods in 2011 and 2010, respectively. Of the amount received this year, \$44,931,822 relates to 2012 assessments and \$23,724,212 relates to prior years.
- 3. The balance of assessed contributions remaining due as of 31 July 2012 totals \$61,602,243 and is comprised of \$61,313,178 in current year assessments and \$289,065 pertaining to assessments for prior years.
- 4. To provide the 28th Pan American Sanitary Conference with the latest information, an Addendum will be issued prior to the Session providing an update on the status of assessed contributions.
- 5. The Executive Committee at its 150th session considered the status of assessed contributions and the special report of the Director on Member States in arrears in an amount exceeding the sum of their assessments for two full years and adopted Resolution CE150.R1, attached (see Annex B).
