


ACHIEVEMENT OF MILLENNIUM DEVELOPMENT GOALS, 2013




Target 6.C: Have halted by 2015 and begun to reverse the incidence of TB.

Indicator 6.9: Incidence, prevalence, and death associated with TB.

Indicator 6.10: Proportion of TB cases detected and cured under supervised treatment.



Estimated mortality, 1990-2013




Target 6.C: TB incidence has steadily declined since 1990.

Indicator 6.9: TB prevalence and mortality fell more than 50% by 2013.


ACHIEVEMENT OF MILLENNIUM DEVELOPMENT GOALS, 2013

Indicator 6.10: Proportion of TB cases detected and cured under supervised treatment.

Treatment success rate, 1994-2012



Indicator 6.10:

- The detection rate in 2013 was 77%, surpassing the 2015 target of 70%.
- The treatment success rate for the 2012 cohort of new TB cases (all types) was 75%, lower than the 2015 target of 85%.
