Objectives

OB

- Assess the PCT of Artesunate for seven days in the Tx of P.f in Guyana.
- Measure the PCT with blood sampling for parasites counts every 8 hrs.
- Artesunate for seven (7) days followed by Primaquine

Inclusion

03

Patient enrolled from Central Vector Control Department

- > >2 years old
- Only P. falciparum by microscopy
- Parasitemia of 1000-100,000/ ul asexual forms
- > Temp >37.5°C or a hx of fever in the past 24 hrs
- Ability to swallow
- Willingness to comply

Process



- Confirmation of results
- Patient is then enrolled after consenting etc
- Transported to hotel
- > All laboratory and treatment are started at 2 pm sharp
- Smear is taken off once again at 10pm as well as Tx and vitals etc
- And again at 6 am
- Continues in this fashion for seven (7) days
- Then sent home on day 7 and followed up day 14, day 21 and day 28 (smears, filter paper, vitals etc

Treatment


CB

- Artesunate 4mg/kg per day
- ➤ Primaquine 0.75mg/kg on day 7

- Mounting Medium was of poor quality and damaged smear
- Quality of stain is questionable
- ➤ P. vivax was noticeable in 3 patients after being enrolled on day 21 (1) and 28 (2).
