

Studies on pharmaceutical policies

 - (2) multicomponents policy
 - (3) theoretical failure vs implementation failures
 - (4) national scope
 - Narrow evaluative questions
 - Inadequate research methods/ dtudy design
 - Biases and self censure

Determining the implementation level requires

- (1) specify the components of the intervention;
- (2) identify practices required to the implementation;
- (3) describe ongoing practices involved to the implementation;
- (4) analyze context contribution.

- Previous studies in LAC region show advancements on pharmaceutical policies implementation
- However, it is still missing a good understanding on which are the success factors to a good implementation level

Objective

 Propose a framework to pharmaceutical policy implementation evaluation considering context influence
