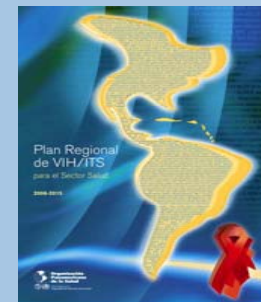

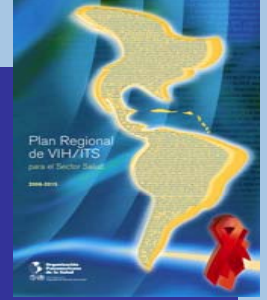


# Objectives TAC 2006
