Invitation to Contributors

The BOLETIN is a journal of the Pan-American Foot-and-Mouth Disease Center (PAHO/WHO). It publishes articles relating to all aspects of work in laboratory, field and program activities of foot-and-mouth disease and other viral diseases in animals. The Director invites contributors to submit their work to the Editorial Committee in the most appropriate of the following formats:

Article: full-length scientific work, reporting on original research, with traditional divisions of Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions, References and Acknowledgments. An abstract of no more than 250 words should accompany the article.

Brief Report: short (6-7 typewritten pages) complete scientific work: results and discussion can be presented with the data, which should be limited to 2 tables.

Preliminary Communication: short summary of work in progress; 3-4 pages; maximum of 2 tables.

Review Article: on both general and specific topics, flexible format.

Languages: Articles may be in Spanish, English or Portuguese and will be published only in the original language submitted by the authors. Summaries will be translated and published in the other two languages. The English version of articles in Spanish or Portuguese will be published only when submitted by the authors.

Instructions to Authors

1. All manuscripts presented to the BOLETIN should be typewritten and double-spaced on one side of 28 x 22 cm paper. The original manuscript should be accompanied by three photocopies and a computer diskette containing the text and tables in any PC word-processing software, though Microsoft Word is preferred.
2. Author's name, title, institution and address should be given on a separate sheet.
3. Figures and tables (arabic numbers) with appropriate captions and titles should be included on separate pages, numbered consecutively and attached at the end of the text with an indication of where they belong.
4. References cited should be listed separately in alphabetical order with appropriate reference numbers in the text.
5. The Editor reserves the right to accept or reject any Manuscript which is submitted, with the understanding that it is subject to editorial revision, including, where necessary, condensation of the text and omission of tabular and illustrative material, etc.
6. Authors will receive the corresponding Boletin.
