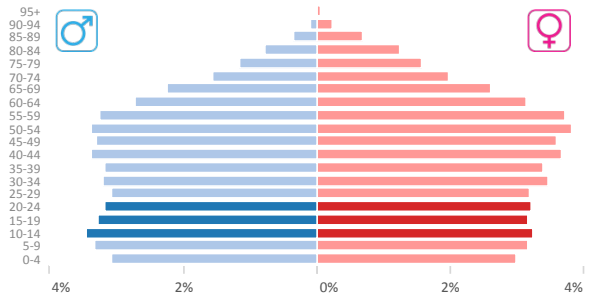

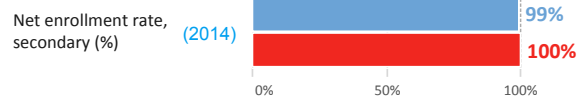

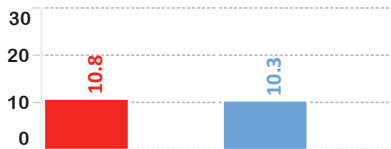
### MORTALITY RATES - Four Leading Causes of Death, by Age Group and Sex (per 100,000 Population)

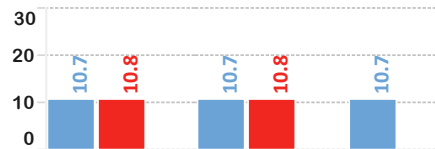

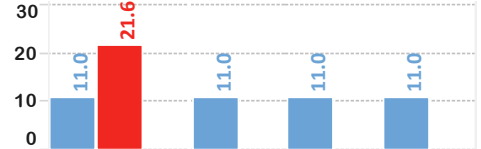

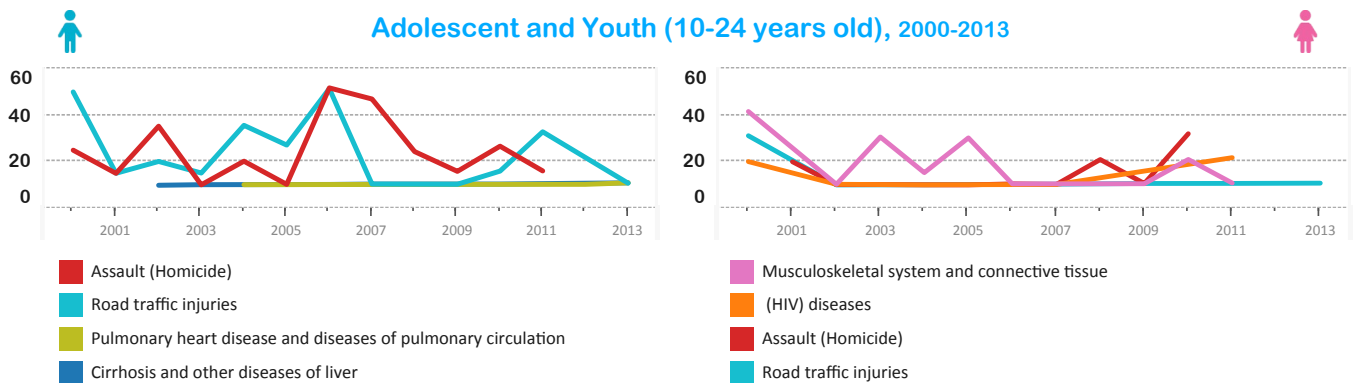

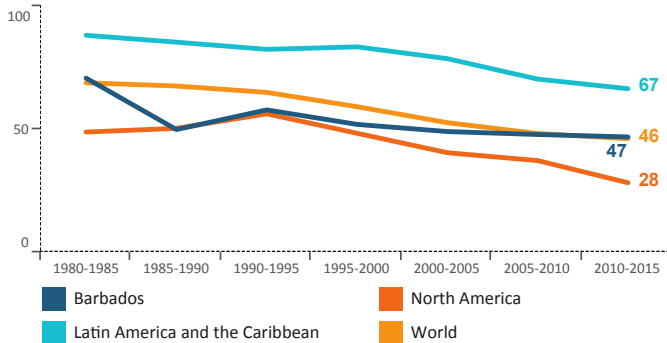

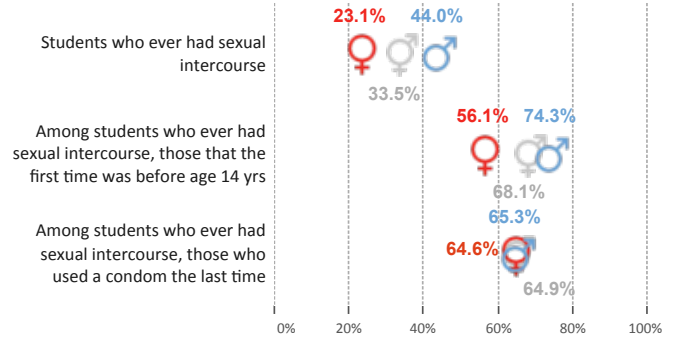
#### Trends in Adolescent Fertility Rate (Births per 1,000 women ages 15-19 years old), 1980-2015

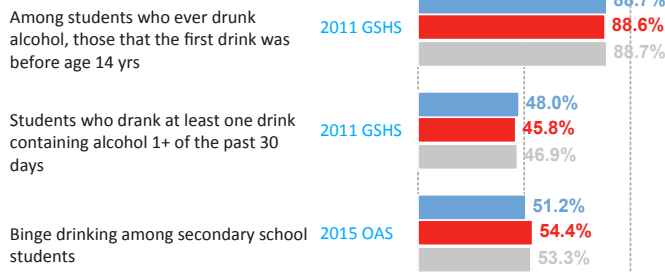

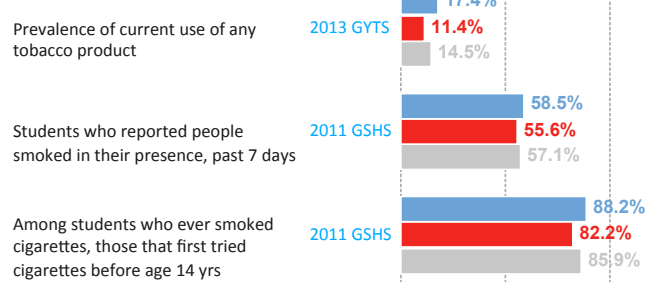
