

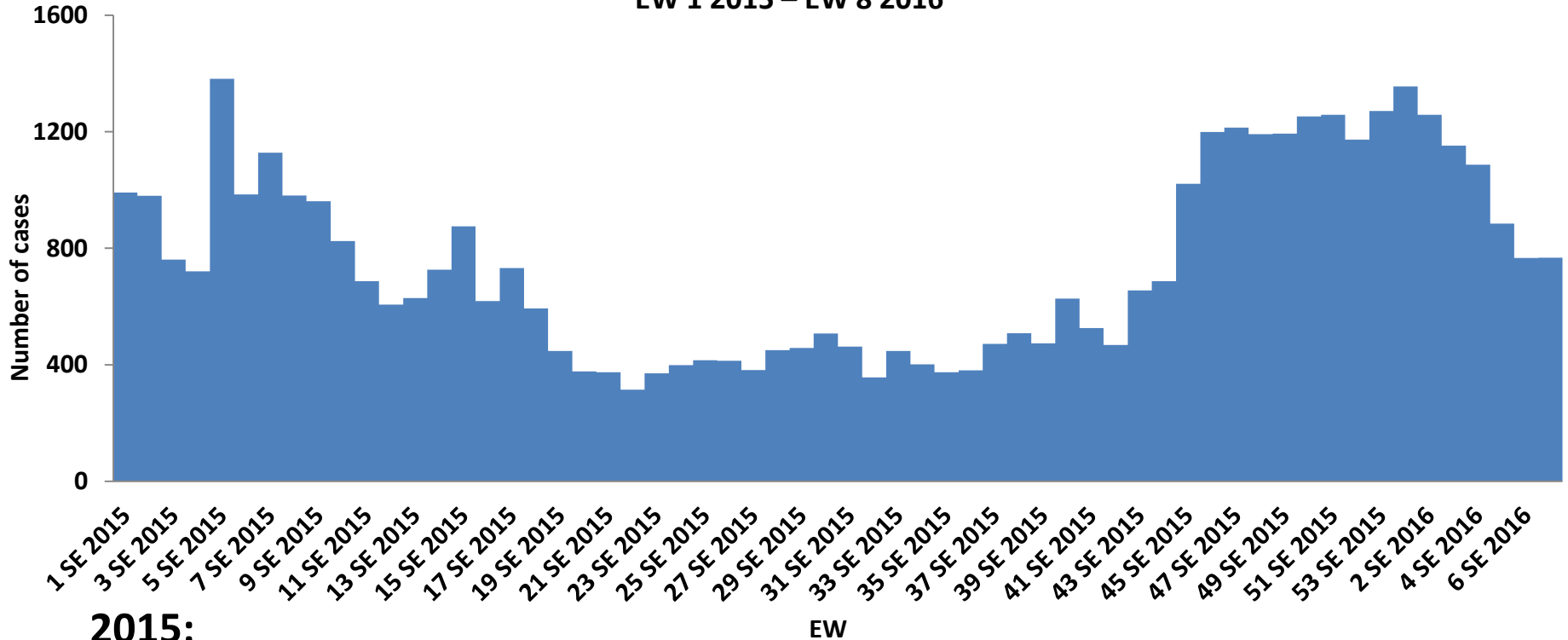


Update Cholera situation Haiti

2015 -2016

Based on MoH available data until EW 8, 2016

Suspected cases EW 1 2015 – EW 8 2016



2015:

Total; 36045 cases

Oct – Dec: cumulated 11838 cases = lowest incidence since 2010.

Oct - Dec: 986 cases per EW compared 1456 cases same period 2014

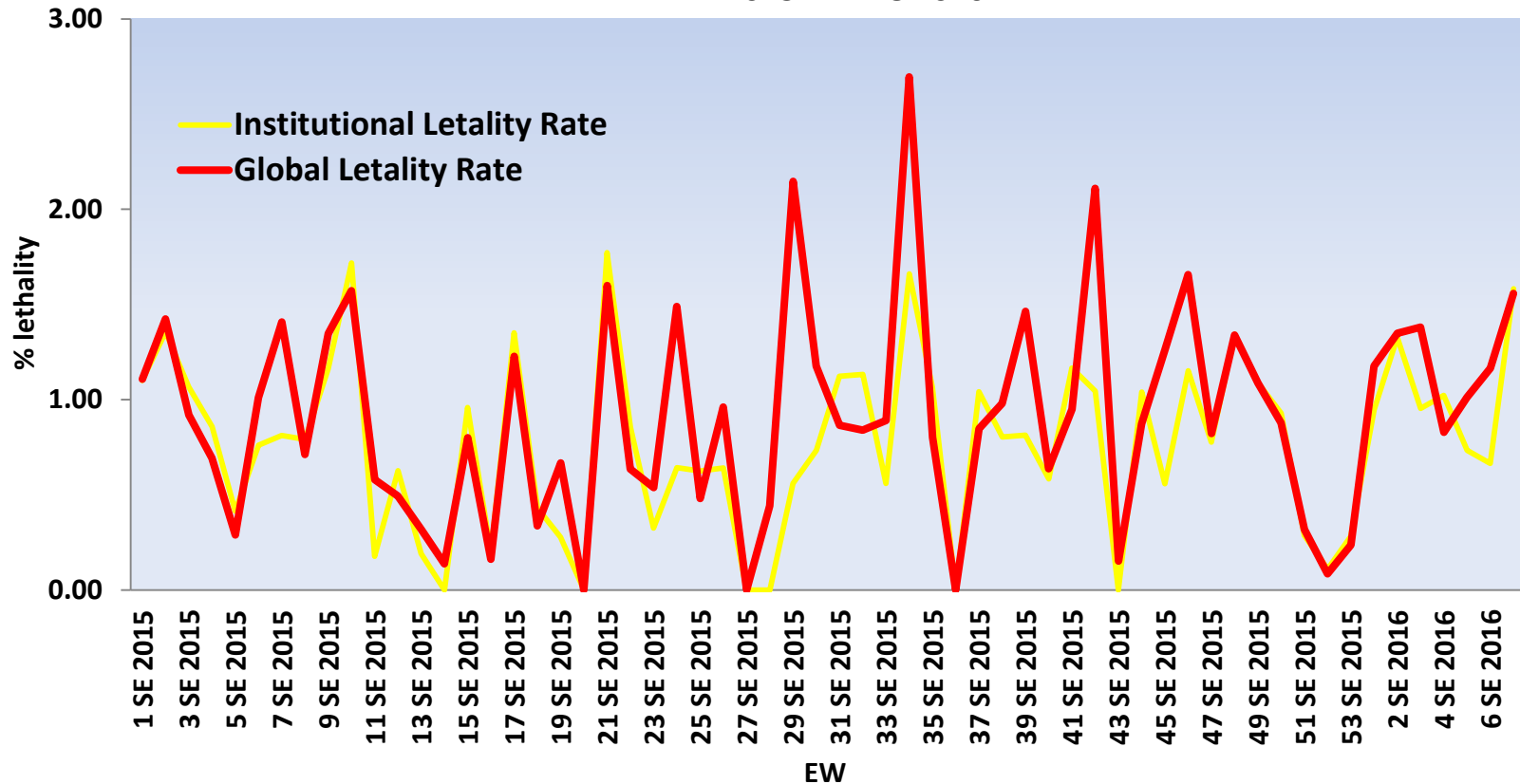
2016:

total: 7782 (EW 8)

972 cases per EW compared to 990 same period 2015

Institutional and global lethality

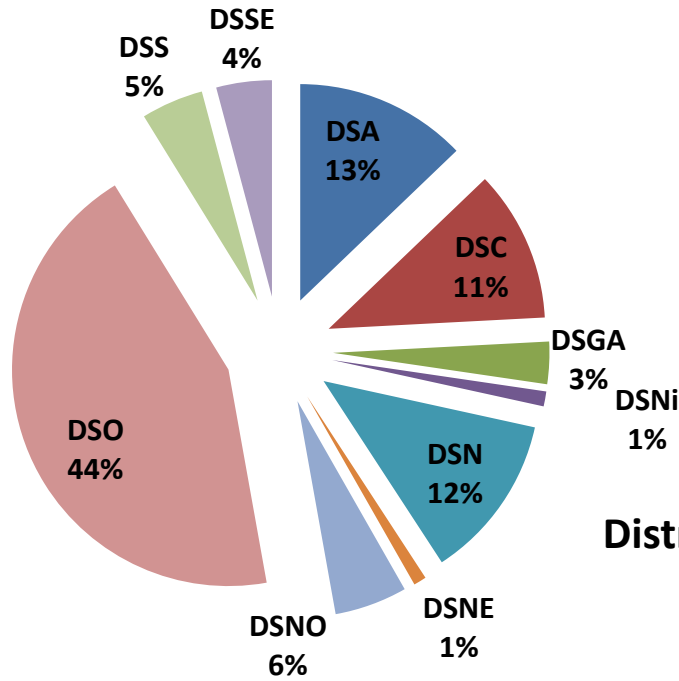
EW 1 2015 – EW 8 2016



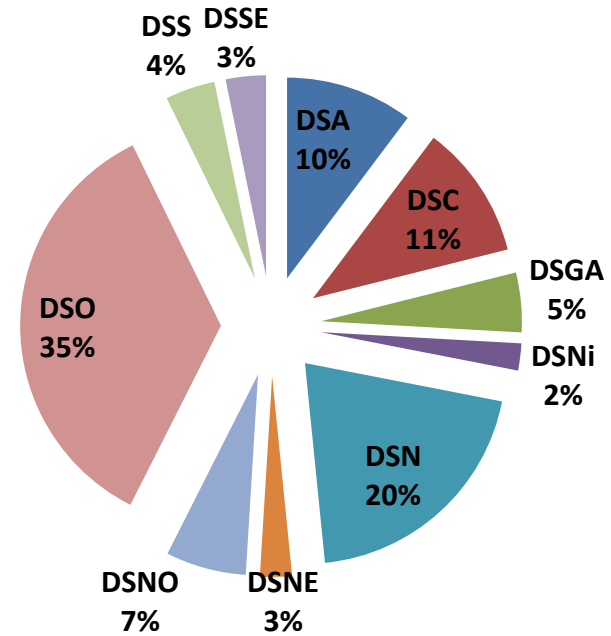
2015: 224 inst. deceases and 98 in community. (ILR= 0.75 %)

2016: 65 inst. deceases and 31 in community. 96 deceases against 74 in 2015 same period (ILR= 1.02%)

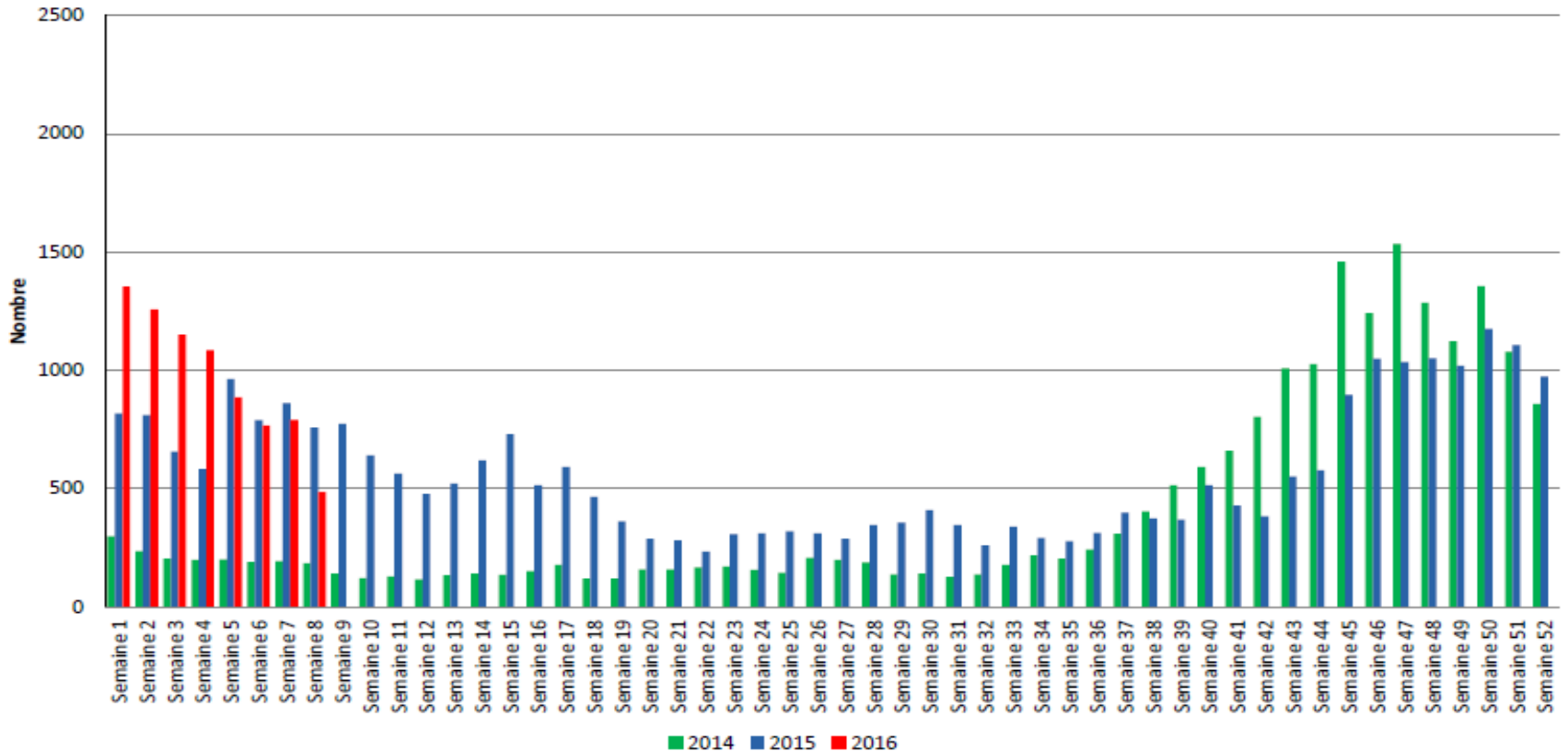
Distribution of cases by Departments 2015

Nouveaux Cas hospitalisés, Haïti , 8ème Semaine Epidémiologique, 2014 - 2016



- Increase of cases was observed since mid-October 2015, but not at same pace of the resurgence of last quarter of 2014.
- 2016 starts with higher incidence compared to 2015 for the first four EW but this tendency reverts from EW 5 to EW 8. Globally from EW 1 to EW 8 nr. of cases decreases despite heavy rains
- In 2016, 76% of cases concentrates in Center; Artibonite; North and West departments. Up to 24 municipalities were in “red alert”.
- Institutional deaths are increasing in 2016 compared to same period of 2015
- ILR is over 1% in both 2015 and 2016 in North: Artibonite; North-West and Nippes
- Outbreaks are more efficiently controlled including in Metropolitan Area of Port au Prince, response is provided in less than 48h in 90% of the cases
