II. Process for submission and evaluation of projects

The Steering Committee became aware of the five projects received prior to the Conference and decided to issue comments and questions on the projects by 11 November 2016. The Secretariat will transmit these comments and/or questions received to the proposers. Proposers will have until November 25, 2016 to present answers and make the adjustments that are required to the projects.

Revised and adjusted projects will be sent to the SC members for evaluation and decision at a virtual meeting to be held in the week of December 12, 2016. The SC recommendations should indicate the value added for the Network as well as the activities to be carried out. Once again, it was specified that the projects should respond to the priorities of the Region and meet the criteria defined by the Network in the document "Procedure for Prioritization of Areas and Selection of Projects"

The five projects are listed bellow:

- "Network for sharing information in the Americas on global regulatory convergence initiatives" proposed by ANVISA/Brazil, FDA/USA and HC/Canada.
- "Non-prescription drugs: From the traditional model to new regulatory feedback scenario" proposed by ANMAT/Argentina, ANVISA/Brazil, INVIMA/Colombia and COFREPRIS/Mexico
- "Strengthening of regulatory capacity on medical devices in the Region of the Americas" proposed by INVIMA/Colombia and CECMED/Cuba.
- "Development of an online system for the identification of registered drugs in support of postmarketing surveillance and the struggle against counterfeit, fraudulent, and contraband medicines in the Republic of Colombia and the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela" proposed by INVIMA/Colombia and INRHH/Venezuela.
- "Creation of a Distance Learning platform for professionals in the national regulatory authorities (NRAs) of the Region of the Americas" proposed by Instituto Racine/Brazil.

III. Call for new Projects

New projects are going to be accepted starting on 1 January 2017. New proposals will be presented to the SC for evaluation and recommendation in the semester after the receipt of the projects. Nonetheless, this procedure will have to be deeply discussed during the next SC meeting. The Secretariat is in charge of presenting a process flow for new projects' submission by the next SC meeting.
