

RESOLUTIONS AND DECISIONS¹

WHA3.22 Trachoma

The Third World Health Assembly,

Considering the high incidence and the wide distribution of trachoma and the possibility of successfully eradicating it by the application of modern methods of control,

REQUESTS the Director-General to take the necessary steps to convene, as soon as the budget permits and preferably in 1951, an expert committee to study the problem of trachoma with a view to submitting practical recommendations to the Fourth World Health Assembly.
