
This situation update is on the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) reported cases and deaths, Globally, Regionally, for Barbados and Eastern Caribbean Countries, French Territories and the United Kingdom Overseas Territories.

- The COVID-19 pandemic continues to create an acute shortage of essential supplies, including personal protective equipment, diagnostics and medical equipment. WHO continues strengthening supply networks, forecasting required supplies, sending critical shipments to countries for their COVID-19 response and processing country requests for critical supplies through a global supply chain coordination platform.
- > WHO's priority is that frontline health workers are able to access essential health supplies, including personal protective equipment, including medical masks and respirators.
- WHO is constantly analyzing data as we receive it and working closely with global experts on a range of topics. To better understand the transmission, epidemiology and clinical features of the virus, WHO has developed research protocols that are being used in more than 40 countries, in a coordinated way.
- > WHO is working with our networks of researchers and other experts to coordinate global work on surveillance, epidemiology, forecasting, diagnostics, clinical care and treatment, and other ways to identify, manage the disease and limit onward transmission.



## **PAHO's Response**



PAHO provides direct technical assistance to strengthen laboratory testing in the Eastern Caribbean Countries:

- ➤ The PAHO Incident Management Team (IMT) includes a laboratory team that has trained and equipped national laboratories of the Eastern Caribbean including Barbados. As commercial flights are unavailable since mid-March in most of the countries, the lab team and the IMT in the Barbados country office use remote communications including video calls to troubleshoot in labs.
- ➤ The national lab in Barbados was trained in February by a PAHO virologist, on the use of the La Charite PCR protocol.
- > PAHO from February to 10 April has implemented regionally 5 rounds of shipments of *primers*, *probes*, *positive controls* (both in-house and kits formats), *enzymes* and *RNA extraction kits*.
- During this period PAHO has provided Barbados with enough reagents for running 18,000 PCR tests (last shipment on 9 April with 11,000 tests).
- ➤ The Caribbean Public Health Agency (CARPHA) has also received from PAHO as a donation in multiple rounds of shipment *primers*, *probes*, *positive controls* (total of 29,000 PCR Totests), *enzymes* and *RNA extraction kits*.
- CARPHA is supporting countries and territories with no laboratory capacities.
- ➤ All Caribbean countries and territories with PCR capacity *Antigua & Barbuda*, *St Kitts and Nevis*, *Dominica*, *Saint Lucia*, *St Vincent and the Grenadines*, *Grenada*, will receive tests and other reagents before the end of April according to needs.
