This situation update is on the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) reported cases and deaths, Globally, Regionally, for Barbados and Eastern Caribbean Countries, French Territories and the United Kingdom Overseas Territories.

Currently, there is insufficient evidence for or against the use of any type of mask among healthy people in public settings. As new information and evidence about mask and non-medical mask emerges, WHO will update existing guidance. WHO continues to gather data and review new studies to find additional ways to protect people from COVID-19.


WHO advises national policy makers to apply a risk-based approach to their decisions about mask use that includes:

- Purpose of mask use (protecting the wearer against infection or preventing the wearer transmitting infection to others);
- ➤ Risk of **exposure** to the COVID-19 due to epidemiology/number of cases in the population or occupation of individuals;
- Vulnerability of the mask wearer/population;
- > Setting in which the population lives in terms of population density and ability for COVID-19 to rapidly spread;
- Feasibility: availability and costs of masks, and ability of mask wearers to tolerate adverse effects of wearing a mask;
- > Type of mask: medical mask versus non-medical mask (prioritization of medical masks for health care providers, symptomatic people and their caregivers).

PAHO Director calls to accelerate and expand testing for COVID-19 in the Americas

Washington, DC, April 21, 2020 (PAHO)— The Director of the Pan American Health Organization (PAHO), Carissa F. Etienne, called for accelerated and expanded testing for COVID-19 in countries of the Americas. "We need a clearer view of where the virus is circulating and how many people have been infected in order to guide our actions," she said.

Speaking at a virtual press briefing, Dr. Etienne said, "The pandemic continues to impact our region, and it's vital for all countries to actively embrace preventive measures, while preparing for more cases, hospitalizations and deaths."

The PAHO Director said that countries have been prepared to test and detect cases of COVID-19 since before the pandemic was declared. Since February, PAHO had trained and equipped laboratories for PCR testing in more than 30 countries. But as cases have increased, countries have found it increasingly difficult to keep up, she noted.
