

This situation update is on the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) reported cases and deaths, Globally, Regionally, for Barbados and Eastern Caribbean Countries, French Territories and the United Kingdom Overseas Territories.


- ➤ Based on the data available, around 300,000 patients have been reported to have recovered from the disease. The WHO has limited information on whether a person infected with the virus develop an antibody response and for how long.
- This remains an unknown, more information is needed from recovered patients to continue investigating this question and have a full picture of whether they develop an immunity to the virus.
- Studies are underway and a number of serological tests are currently available, the WHO will closely monitor the findings of these investigations.
- According to our clinical management guidelines, a COVID-19 patient can be discharged from isolation after two consecutive negative test results in a clinically recovered patient at least 24 hours apart.
