


- Although professional health workers like doctors and nurses play crucial roles, in many countries trained members of the community play a vital role in delivering essential health services like vaccination, pre-natal screening, and the detection, prevention and management of many diseases.
- WHO, the International Federation of the Red Cross and Red Crescent (IFRC) and UNICEF, jointly released the <u>Risk</u> <u>Communication and Community Engagement (RCCE) Action</u> <u>Plan Guidance for COVID-19</u> and the <u>Community-based health</u> <u>care guidance</u>, which outlines the adaptations needed to keep people safe, maintain continuity of essential health services and ensure an effective response to COVID-19.
- IFRC, UNICEF and WHO, in close coordination with the Global Outbreak Alert and Response Network (GOARN) and support from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, are working towards the establishment of a RCCE Global Collective Service to assist the public health and humanitarian response. This will build on the existing coordination efforts towards providing global, regional and country support across to the health and humanitarian architecture.


