

This situation update is on the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) reported cases and deaths, Globally, Regionally, for Barbados and Eastern Caribbean Countries, French Territories and the United Kingdom Overseas Territories.

COVID-19 and the Workplace

- Before people can more safely go back to work in countries where workplaces are reopening, a workplace risk assessment should be carried out to determine the level of exposure risk (low, medium or high) and better plan preventive measures to be implemented.
- It should be carried out for each specific work setting and each job. The risk of work-related exposure to COVID-19 depends on the probability of coming into close with people who may be infected with COVID-19 and through contact with contaminated surfaces and objects.
- The employers, in consultation with workers and their representatives, should take preventive and protective measures, which will not involve any expenditure on the part of workers. Workplaces should develop action plans for prevention and mitigation of COVID-19 as part of the business continuity plan and according to the results of the risks assessment and the epidemiological situation.
