IMMUNIZATION VACENATON **DURING THE PANDEMIC 10 TIPS FOR HEALTH SERVICES**

- Keep the community informed about vaccination hours, locations, safety precautions and changes that might affect vaccination services during the pandemic using all communications channels.
- Disinfect the entire area often. 3. Vaccinate in well-ventilated spaces or outside. 4. Keep vaccination services separate from other health services when possible. 5. Reorganize services to avoid crowded waiting rooms and facilitate physical distancing. 6. Organize pre-scheduled times for immunization appointments, including immunization sessions exclusively for vaccination of older persons and those with pre-existing medical conditions. Permit only one parent or caregiver to be present during a child's immunization visit. 8. Ensure the public has access to hand sanitizer or handwashing units with chlorinated water at the entrance to the facility.
- Make sure that everyone who comes to the health 9 service is asked about their vaccination status.
- Never miss an opportunity to vaccinate. Always check patients' immunization records when they seek any routine health service.
