






HIV incidence per 1000 population, 2030 forecast and targets for Ending AIDS, in Latin America and the Caribbean, 1995-2030






AIDS mortality estimates, 2030 forecast, and targets for Ending AIDS in Latin America and the Caribbean, 2000-2030






New HIV infections, deaths and persons living with HIV receiving ART in Latin America and the Caribbean, 1995-2019






Antiretroviral treatment coverage in Latin America and the Caribbean, 1995-2019






Antiretroviral treatment coverage in the Caribbean, 2000-2019










- Among people living with HIV- the percent on ART

HIV cascade of care in Latin America and the Caribbean, 2017-2019










Distribution of new HIV infections (aged 15–49 years), by population group, Latin America and the Caribbean, 2019






Persons with late HIV diagnosis (baseline CD4<200 cell/mm3) (%) in Latin America and the Caribbean, 2016-2019












ART coverage by sex among adults per WHO Region (2019)







ARV disruptions due to COVID-19, in Latin America and the Caribbean, October 2020




- One country suffered disruption consisting of delayed supply or stock-out of ARVs, reagents, and medicines for opportunistic infections.
- Countries had to accelerate or operationalize unplanned transitions, use alternative ARVs or regimens, etc. this has caused a lot of stress on programs, services and users, but the risk of stock-outs has been minimized.
- Data not available for 14 countries (stock information was not reported to PAHO). However, in these countries supply chain management for ARVs was not significantly affected.




Multi-month dispensing of ARVs available during the COVID-19 pandemic, 2020

Latin America (n=15 countries)




The Caribbean (n=13 countries)




Status of HIV self-testing (HIVST) in national policies, updated July 2020






PrEP Implementation in Latin America and the Caribbean, 2017-2020





"Treat all" policy uptake for adult and adolescents living with HIV






Rapid Initiation of Treatment in National Policies in Latin America and the Caribbean, **July 2020**





Preferred first line regimen among adults and adolescents in low- and middle-income countries, 2020







Estimated new HIV infections and AIDS deaths in Latin America and the Caribbean, 2004-2019










People with HIV that know their status, by sex in Latin America and the Caribbean (%), 2019






Children (0-14 years old) receiving antiretroviral treatment (%), by subregion in Latin America and the Caribbean, 2017-2019





Viral load testing and suppression, in Latin America and the Caribbean, 2015-2019






Persons receiving antiretroviral treatment by country, by age group and sex, in the Caribbean 2016-2019





Percentage of persons receiving antiretroviral treatment among persons with HIV by country, by age group and sex, in Latin America 2016-2019









Persons living with HIV and persons receiving ART in Latin America and the Caribbean, 2000-2019






HIV testing coverage among pregnant women by subregion, 2010-2019









Antiretroviral coverage among pregnant women with HIV and final MTCT transmission rate. Latin America and the Caribbean, 2010-2019






Antiretroviral coverage among pregnant women with HIV and final MTCT transmission rate, by subregion, 2010-2019






Number of new child HIV infections and infections averted due to PMTCT. The Caribbean, 1990-2019






Number of new child HIV infections and infections averted due to PMTCT in Latin America, 1990-2019






Prevalence of HIV infection in sex workers, latest reported data






Prevalence of HIV infection in MSM, latest reported data






Prevalence of HIV infection in transgender women, latest reported data






Condom use among sex workers in Latin America and the Caribbean, by subregion, latest year available (2011-2019)






Condom use among MSM in Latin America and the Caribbean, by subregion, latest year available (2011-2019)






Condom use among transgender women in Latin America and the Caribbean, by subregion, latest year available (2011-2019)






Active syphilis among female sex workers, latest reported data - 2017-2019







Active syphilis among MSM, latest reported data -2016-2019






Trend in HIV tests performed and positive conformed results, in 8 countries of Latin America and the Caribbean, January to June 2020








Trend in the number of people initiating antiretroviral therapy (ART) in Latin America and the Caribbean, January to June 2020







Trend in the number of people with a viral load determination in 4 countries of Latin America and the Caribbean, January to July 2020
