WHO Director-General calls on world to "choose health" at resumed 73rd World Health Assembly in the Year of the Nurse and the Midwife

The resumed 73rd World Health Assembly (WHA73) opened to the tune of the classic hit song <u>"We are Family" by Sister Sledge</u>, the Kingdom of Tonga' Nurses' Choir and a <u>powerful speech by the WHO Director-General</u> calling for predictable and sustainable WHO funding, the launch of a Universal Health and Preparedness Review and the need to "reimagine" global leadership and "forge a new era of cooperation" reflecting the lessons of the COVID-19 pandemic.


