
Summary of the current situation

Up to 31 May 2009, **16,018 confirmed cases** of the new virus influenza A (H1N1) infection, including **115 deaths**, have been notified in **22 countries** of the Americas: Argentina, Bahamas, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, **Jamaica**, Mexico, Paraguay, Panama, Peru, United States, Uruguay and Venezuela. **(Figure 1)**

In the Americas Region, there were **71 confirmed cases** more than the previous day. No new deaths were notified. **Jamaica** confirmed its first two cases of influenza A (H1N1).

WHO is not recommending any travel restrictions related to the outbreak of the *Influenza* A (H1N1) virus.
