Summary of the current situation

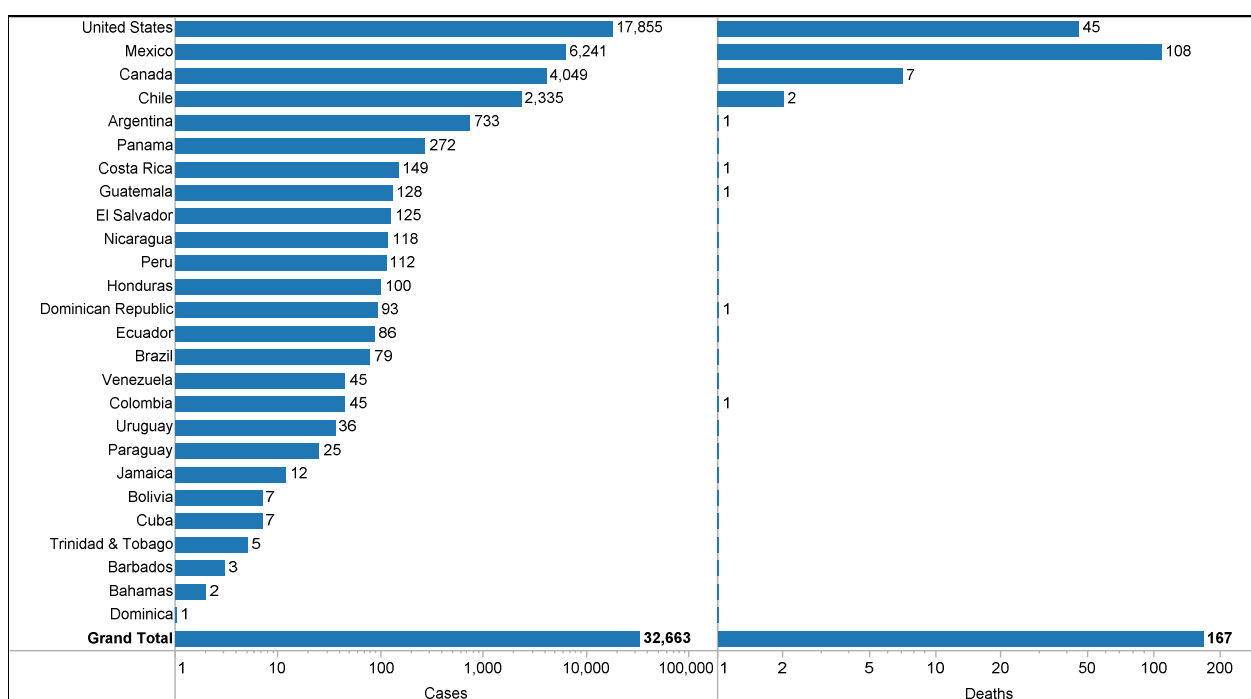
As of 16 June 2009, **32,663 confirmed cases** of the new virus influenza A (H1N1) infection, including **167 deaths**, have been notified in **26 countries** of the Americas: Argentina, Bahamas, Barbados, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Paraguay, Panama, Peru, United States, Trinidad and Tobago, Uruguay and Venezuela. WHO is not recommending any travel restrictions related to the outbreak of the *Influenza A (H1N1)* virus.

In the Americas Region, there were **224** additional **confirmed cases** compared to previous day. **Argentina** notified its first death caused by the new influenza A (H1N1) virus.

The following overseas territories have confirmed cases of influenza A (H1N1): Bermuda, UK (1); Cayman Islands, UK (4); Virgin Islands, UK (1); and Martinique, French Department (1).
