



Regional update Pandemic H1N1 2009

(22 June 2009 – 23 h GMT; 18 h EST)

Summary of the current situation

As of 22 June 2009, **43,393 confirmed cases** of the new influenza A (H1N1) virus, including **235 deaths**, have been notified in **27 countries** of the Americas: Argentina, Bahamas, Barbados, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Paraguay, Panama, Peru, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, United States, Uruguay and Venezuela. 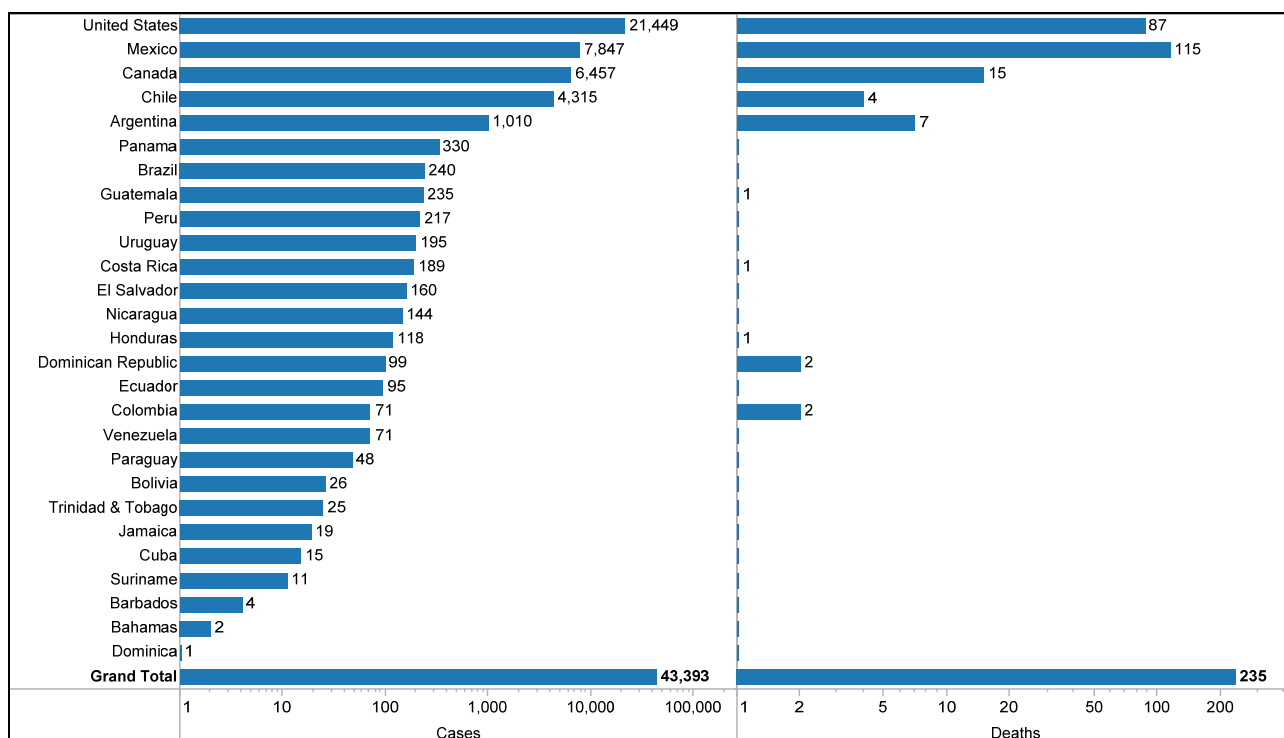
WHO is not recommending any travel restrictions related to the *Pandemic H1N1 2009*.

In the Americas Region, there were **1,492 additional confirmed cases** compared to day 19 June 2009.

Honduras confirmed its first death caused by the new influenza A (H1N1) virus.

The following overseas territories have confirmed cases of new influenza A (H1N1): Bermuda, UK Overseas Territory (1); Cayman Islands, UK Overseas Territory (4); British Virgin Islands, UK Overseas Territory (1); Martinique, French Overseas Community (1); and Netherlands Antilles, St. Maarten (1).
