

BIG Goals

WHO Global Monitoring Framework with targets and indicators

Set of 9 voluntary global NCD targets for 2025



By 2025 the prevalence of raised blood pressure will be reduced by 25%

BIGGER Barriers . . .

Patient

 Limited access and poor adherence to treatment

Health Care Provider

- Raised blood pressure attributed to "white coat" hypertension
- Reluctance to treat an asymptomatic condition
- Lack of adequate time with patient
- Therapeutic inertia
- Lack of adherence to current treatment guidelines





BIGGER Barriers . . .

Health Systems

- Failure to delegate responsibility to nonphysicians
- Inappropriate follow-up
- Absence of feedback to clinicians
- Issues related to supply, distribution, and cost of medications
- Complex medication regimens






Even BIGGER solutions needed . .

- Strategy
- □ Guidelines
- Registries/Information Systems
- Medications
- Patient-Centeredness (including self-management interventions)
- Care System (organizational management to implement a primary health care-led system)
- Community


Pilot Overview

- Launched at TWO PRIMARY CARE SITES
- Objectives
 - Creation of a hypertension registry
 - Identification and availability of core set of antihypertensive drugs
 - Standardized protocols for the Screening and Management of Hypertension





A Tedious Process



Take Home Points

- 1. Implementation of an EBM guideline is feasible
- 2. Generation of Registries allow for production KPIs in health.
- 3. Registries linking health data with pharmaceutical data provide critical therapeutic metrics.
- 4. Implementation of an EBM guideline can result in Rx practice







Take Home Points

- 5. Having a Rx Filled resulted in better control.
- 6. BP control rates improved at both 12 &18 month time points
- 7. The use of a standardized treatment algorithm resulted in a behavioral change in prescribers







Key POINT

The single most important factor for the **SUSTAINABILITY** of the SHTP is the establishment of a robust **Health Information System (HIS)** monitoring key performance metrics with **active feedback** to HCP
