


The Facility:

- 2 warehouses : 2,900 M2
  - Promess an average of 160- Essentials drugs & medical supplies, Family planning & maternal Health Commodities, Cholera Commodities, Emergencies commodities, Donations (humanitarian/crisis situation)
- 5 cold chambers: 200 M3
  - $\circ$  Vaccines –
- Serves an average of 120 health institutions;
  - 5 PAHO-Who-Essential Drug Program PROMESS/Haiti

- Establish a Public Health system to ensure the national health coverage for the population by combining national budgetary funds and external aid.
- Rationalize the use of existing resources to improve coordination and management of commodities .
