



The Collaborating Centre for the WHO-FIC in Barcelona, Spain (CC-BCN) initiated the designation process in 2010 and is formally under designation since 2014. The CC-BCN is led by AQUAS, a public entity depending on the Catalan Health Ministry that acts in service of the public policies, and it counts on the participation of more than 20 institutions spread for all the Spanish territory, such as public administration entities, healthcare providers, hospitals, and medical and coders societies. The strategic working plan of the CC-BCN proposes the development of five activities.

Activity ID 5 – Implementation of the current use versions of ICD in the Spanish territory (2015-2018)

- Create a repository of all the Spanish ICD implementation guidelines
- Create a repository of impact assessments and all problems related to the ICD implementation in Spain
- Recognition of the CC-BCN as national stakeholder for ICD implementation strategies

Activity ID 1 – Organization of the WHO FIC Network Annual Meeting in 2014

- Create a common work space of discussion for the WHO-FIC Work Groups
- Collaborate to draw the WHO-FIC Network the roadmap for the forthcoming year
- Disseminate the progress of the ICD and other classifications
- Give visibility to the Spanish-speaking members of the WHO-FIC Network and promote a networking space for these members

Activity ID 2 – Support to the ICD-11th developments (2015-2018)

- Participation in the reference groups meetings and discussions, with special interest in Mortality Reference Group and the Family Development Committee
- Facilitate the adequate codification in the Spanish mortality registries
- Collaborate in the revision and translation of the ICD-11th, with special interest in Mortality codification
- Assist in the development and implementation of the ICD-11th following the WHO-FIC Network guidelines
- Participate in the ICD-11th –SNOMED harmonization process

Activity ID 4 – Dissemination of classification systems and promotion of their added-value (2015-2018)

- Creation of an updated repository of e-learning experiences and tools related to CTS products.
- Participation in scientific activities for promoting CTS products and their added-value through scientific publications, conferences, etc., for example through the participation in the UBISS-PH, July 2014
- Creation of profiles in social networks for CTS products dissemination
- Strengthening bonds with medical, health information management and other related scientific societies.

Activity ID 3 – Uses of ICT and eHealth tools applied to CTS products (2015-2018)

- Increase the use of ICT and eHealth tools among professionals through devices of automatic codification
- Provide professionals with tools that could facilitate implementation of CTS products for clinical and management decision making and research.
