## THE PACKAGE



### Diagnostics:

Immune Status: CD4 measure  
Tuberculosis: urine antigen | Molecular tests  
Histoplasmosis: urine antigen  
Cryptococcosis: Antigen in Serum/Blood/CSF



### Treatment:

Anfotericine B liposomal  
Flucitosine  
Fluconazol  
Itraconazol  
Valganciclovir  
Rifapentine/isonaizide

## HOW TO GET IT

The "Zero AIDS Deaths by 2030" project supports countries with catalytic grants to accelerate the integration of these supplies into national plans, as well as technical cooperation for their implementation.
