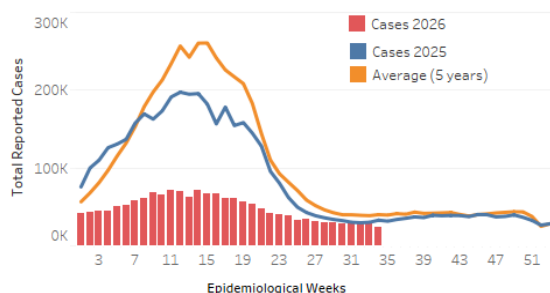


Report on the epidemiological situation of dengue in endemic countries of the Americas

As of epidemiological week 34, 2026. Update: Sep 18 2026 3:21PM (GTM-5)

In the epidemiological week (EW) 34 of 2026, a total of 1,626,962 suspected cases of dengue were reported, resulting in a cumulative incidence of 156 cases per 100,000 population. This represents a decrease of 57% compared to the same period in 2025 and 64% compared to the average of the last 5 years. Figure 1 shows the trend of suspected dengue cases as of EW 34.

Out of the 1,626,962 reported dengue cases in the Region, 496,051 cases (30%) were laboratory-confirmed, and 3,218 (0.2%) were classified as severe dengue. A total of 521 deaths have been recorded, resulting in a case fatality rate (CFR) of 0.032%.

13 countries and territories within the region reported dengue cases in epidemiological week (EW) 34, accounting for 24,381 new suspected cases. Of these, 36 were classified as severe dengue (0.2%), and 7 deaths reported, yielding a case fatality rate of 0.029%. The distribution of cases by country is detailed in Table 1.

Analysis by subregion

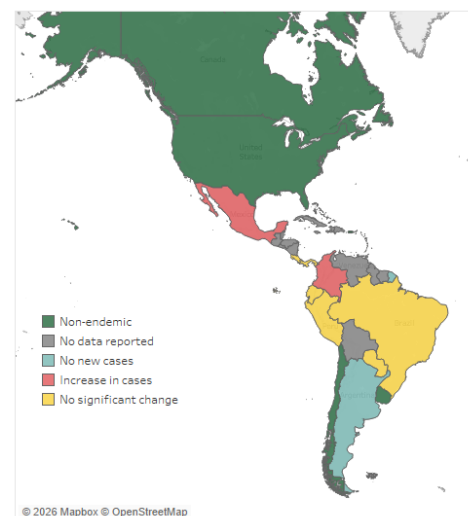
Central America and Mexico Sub-region. A total of 2,743 new suspected dengue cases were registered in EW 34. As of this week, the subregion exhibits an decrease of 42% compared to the same week in 2025 and 61% compared to the average of the last five years (Figure 3). The cases reported this week by México represent an increase of 26% compared to the previous four epidemiological weeks (Figure 2).

Caribbean Sub-region. 14 new suspected dengue cases were registered in EW 34. As of this week, the subregion exhibits an decrease of 59% compared to the same week in 2025 and 60% compared to the average of the last five years (Figure 4).

Andean Sub-region. In EW 34, 6,463 new suspected dengue cases were registered. As of this week, the subregion exhibits an decrease of 5% compared to the same week in 2025 and 22% compared to the average of the last five years (Figure 5). The cases reported this week by Colombia represent an increase of 14% compared to the previous four epidemiological weeks (Figure 2).

Southern Cone Sub-region. 15,161 new suspected dengue cases were reported in EW 34. As of this week, the subregion exhibits an decrease of 62% compared to the same week in 2025 and 68% compared to the average of the last five years (Figure 6).
