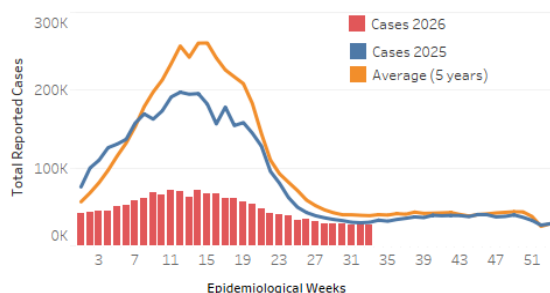


Report on the epidemiological situation of dengue in endemic countries of the Americas

As of epidemiological week 33, 2026. Update: Sep 11 2026 4:11PM (GTM-5)

In the epidemiological week (EW) 33 of 2026, a total of 1,599,333 suspected cases of dengue were reported, resulting in a cumulative incidence of 153 cases per 100,000 population. This represents a decrease of 58% compared to the same period in 2025 and 64% compared to the average of the last 5 years. Figure 1 shows the trend of suspected dengue cases as of EW 33.

Out of the 1,599,333 reported dengue cases in the Region, 487,638 cases (30%) were laboratory-confirmed, and 3,176 (0.2%) were classified as severe dengue. A total of 507 deaths have been recorded, resulting in a case fatality rate (CFR) of 0.032%.

18 countries and territories within the region reported dengue cases in epidemiological week (EW) 33, accounting for 27,460 new suspected cases. Of these, 79 were classified as severe dengue (0.2%), and 7 deaths reported, yielding a case fatality rate of 0.025%. The distribution of cases by country is detailed in Table 1.

Analysis by subregion

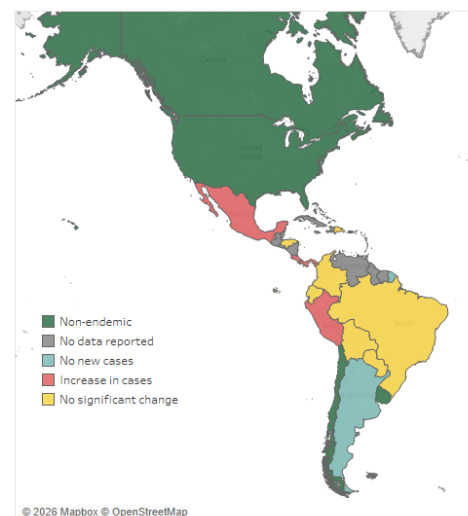
Central America and Mexico Sub-region. A total of 3,471 new suspected dengue cases were registered in EW 33. As of this week, the subregion exhibits an decrease of 42% compared to the same week in 2025 and 59% compared to the average of the last five years (Figure 3). The cases reported this week by México represent an increase of 33%, Costa Rica of 27%, Panamá of 12% compared to the previous four epidemiological weeks (Figure 2).

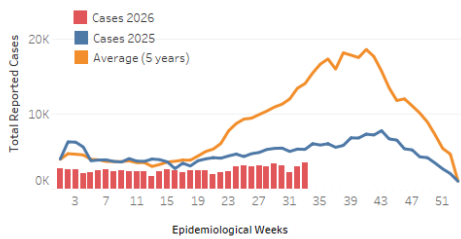


Figure 4. Total number of suspected dengue cases to EW 33 in 2026, 2025 and average of the last 5 years. Caribbean Sub-region.

Caribbean Sub-region. 53 new suspected dengue cases were registered in EW 33. As of this week, the subregion exhibits an decrease of 59% compared to the same week in 2025 and 59% compared to the average of the last five years (Figure 4).

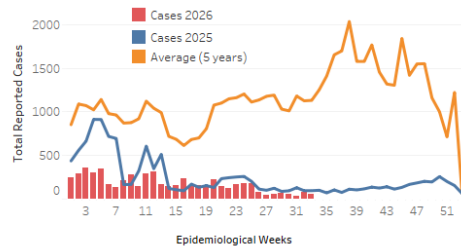


Figure 5. Total number of suspected dengue cases to EW 33 in 2026, 2025 and average of the last 5 years. Andean Sub-region.

Andean Sub-region. In EW 33, 7,189 new suspected dengue cases were registered. As of this week, the subregion exhibits an decrease of 6% compared to the same week in 2025 and 23% compared to the average of the last five years (Figure 5). The cases reported this week by Perú represent an increase of 51% compared to the previous four epidemiological weeks (Figure 2).

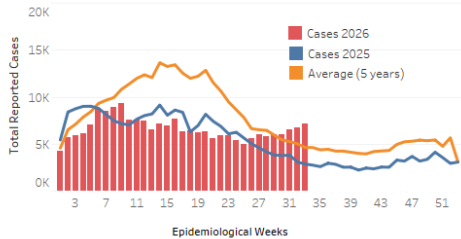
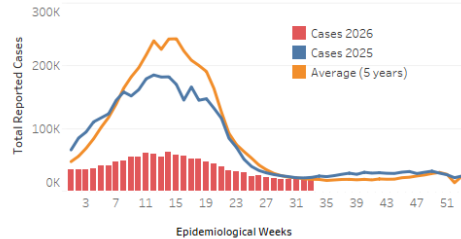


Figure 6. Total number of suspected dengue cases to EW 33 in 2026, 2025 and average of the last 5 years. Southern Cone Sub-region.

Southern Cone Sub-region. 16,747 new suspected dengue cases were reported in EW 33. As of this week, the subregion exhibits an decrease of 63% compared to the same week in 2025 and 68% compared to the average of the last five years (Figure 6).

Figure 3. Total number of suspected dengue cases to EW 33 in 2026, 2025 and average of the last 5 years. Central America and Mexico Sub-region.
