- Plans officially launched 4 countries
- Brazil (2024), Colombia (2024 preliminary strategy), El Salvador (2024), Panama (2025)
- Plans in development 5 countries
- Colombia (detailed plan), Costa Rica, Guatemala, and Honduras to be launched 2nd half 2025
- Chile and Nicaragua draft documents
- El Workshops planned for the second half 2025 7 countries
- Dominican Republic (November 2025)
- Mexico, Surinam, Uruguay, Bolivia, Belize, Venezuela Coordination and advocacy in process
- Implementing elimination strategies 14 countries
- Ecuador, Guyana, Barbados, and 11 OECS


