Recommendations for countries in the Region of the Americas to decrease the risk of a polio outbreak

- Countries should develop a risk mitigation plan and implement the necessary actions to assure high vaccination coverage and a sensitive surveillance system.
- Look for training opportunities on the different components of the polio program for all the health system levels.
- AFP cases that present with fever, asymmetrical paralysis, and have no history of vaccination should be reported immediately
- Expedite the shipment of stool specimens to the corresponding laboratory.
- Have an updated polio outbreak response plan.
- Countries should review the recommendations provided by the RCC in December 2021 and work towards their implementation.
- Polio laboratories should be prepared for a rapid response
