Meals

During the IV Congress (August 20 - 22), participants will receive refreshments and lunch on August 20 and 21.

The Parliament of Uruguay will be offering a welcome dinner to the participants on August 20 and a farewell lunch on August 22 (places to be defined).

The dinner on August 21 will be borne by each participant with his or her own travel allowance.

Language

The official language of Uruguay is Spanish.

Visas and entry requirements to the country

To enter Uruguay, participants must have a passport which should not expire within six (6) months after their travel date.

Participants from countries that require a visa to enter Uruguay, are responsible to request a visa at the Embassy or Consulate of Uruguay in their respective countries with a minimum of 20 days in advance.

Simultaneous Interpretation

The IV Congress will have simultaneous interpretation (English to Spanish and Spanish to English).

Security

Local currency

The local currency is the Uruguayan peso (\$). The current exchange rate is \$ 31.10 pesos per dollar (Source: Central Bank - average value in July 2018).

You can find currency exchange facilities at the airport or in the area near the Four Points Hotel

Weather

The event will be held during the winter of Uruguay. The average temperature ranges from 9 ° C to 15 ° C (48.2°F to 59°F). The month of August is characterized by being rainy and at night the temperature drops, so it is recommended that you bring warm clothes.

Voltage

The electricity in Uruguay is 220 volts. The types of plugs that are used are: schuko models, two and three in line.
